POST-TINT INSTRUCTIONS



Quality You Can Trust: We stand by the quality of our work and materials, using premium film and careful installation on every vehicle.

Do Not Roll Down Windows:

For the first 72 hours post-tinting, please keep your windows rolled up to allow the film to adhere to the glass. DO NOT touch the film.



Avoid Using Rear Defrost:

Just like your side windows, avoid using the rear defrost for 72 hours to prevent any interference with the film's curing process.

Normal Appearance Changes:

It is not uncommon to notice some bubbles or a hazy appearance right after the tinting process. Don't worry; this is **normal**. These minor imperfections are part of the drying process and will resolve themselves as the film cures.



Wait Period:

Give your new tinted windows about **two weeks** before cleaning them. This waiting period ensures the film has had enough time to cure and set properly.

Cleaning Solution:

When you're ready to clean, always use an ammonia-free glass cleaner. Ammonia-based cleaners can break down the tint and cause it to peel or discolor.

Observation Period

Please wait a **full four weeks** after application to ensure the film has completely cured before reporting any issues. This period allows the film to fully dry and adhere.
